JOB SUMMARY

Responsible to the appropriate supervisor through the assigned foreman. *or assigned*

Performs general labouring duties as assigned.

JOB CHARACTERISTICS

Maintains grounds, including lining playing fields, cutting and trimming grassed areas, weeding, irrigating, raking, shoveling and sweeping outside areas.

Assists in the movement of furniture, equipment, supplies, and other materials including lumber.

Operates basic equipment such as lawnmowers, weed eaters, spreaders and trimmers, jack hammers, small power tools, mortar and cement mixers.

Operates fork lift as required.

Erects and dismantles scaffolding and works from same.

Cleans roofs, downspouts, gutters and catch basins.

Reports promptly to the appropriate foreman or supervisor, any mechanical failures or body damage to School Board vehicles, equipment and tools.

Cleans work areas, equipment and tools.

Performs duties in compliance with safety regulations.

Performs other assigned duties related to the above.

JOB QUALIFICATIONS

Must be physically able to perform all duties as noted in the Job Characteristics.

Must be able to work at various heights.

A valid B.C. driver's licence is desirable.

Labourers in the cartage branch MUST possess a valid B.C. driver's licence.

Must be able to undertake his duties in adverse working conditions.

Should possess experience in similiar work.

Maintains a cooperative working relationship with other workers, supervisory and teaching staff, students, and the public.
