JOB CHARACTERISTICS

measures, cuts, trims and shapes stones, blocks, bricks, tiles, and slates prior to setting and installation

mixes, levels, spreads, tamps, sets, fills mortar, plaster and stucco, drywall and taping

grouts, sets and seals tiles, marble, slate and similar materials

erects, dismantles and works from ladders and scaffolding

reports promptly to the appropriate foreman or supervisor, any mechanical failures or body damage to School Board vehicles, equipment and tools

cleans works areas, equipment and tools

performs duties in compliance with safety regulations

performs other assigned duties related to the above,

JOB QUALIFICATIONS

must have proven experience in one or more of the following: masonry, bricklaying, drywalling and plastering

Must possess a certificate of apprenticeship as issued or recognized by the Province of B.C. OR a Certificate of Trade Qualification as issued or recognized by the Province of B.C. for a posted vacancy as of March 10, 1988.

JOB QUALIFICATIONS (cont'd)

must be able to work at various heights

should possess a valid B.C. driver's licence

must be physically able to perform all duties as noted in the Job Characteristics

maintains a cooperative working relationship with other workers, supervisory and teaching staff, students and the public.
