performs plumbing duties as assigned

JOB CHARACTERISTICS

installs, maintains and repairs pipes, fixtures and fittings used for water distribution and drainage of wastes in accordance with the relevant codes and regulations.

installs, maintains and repairs pneumatic and air type piping, fittings, and controls

installs, maintains and rebuilds air compressors

installs, maintains and repairs natural gas and liquid propane systems

installs, maintains and repairs piping and fittings in steam and hot water heating systems, such as pressure valves, relief valves, boiler controls, modulating valves, steam traps, convectors, radiators, etc.

operates hand and power tools, and testing equipment as required

reports promptly to the appropriate foreman or supervisor, any mechanical failures or body damage to School Board vehicles, equipment and tools

cleans works areas, equipment and tools

performs duties in compliance with safety regulations

performs other assigned duties related to the above

JOB QUALIFICATIONS

Must possess a certificate of apprenticeship as issued or recognized by the Province of B.C. OR a Certificate of Trade Qualification as issued or recognized by the Province of B.C. for a posted vacancy as of March 10, 1988.

must be physically able to perform all duties as noted in the Job Characteristics
