performs specialized welding tasks as assigned

JOB CHARACTERISTICS

performs oxyacetylene welding, arc welding and brazing, heli-arc welding for all types of metals including cast iron, steel, stainless steel, monel, duraluminum, aluminum, inconel etc.

forges, designs, fabricates, repairs metal objects such as special equipment, metal furniture etc.

sharpens tools as required

operates auxilliary equipment such as bending jigs, drills, power hacksaws, grinders, etc.

reports promptly to the appropriate foreman or supervisor, any mechanical failures or body damage to School Board vehicles, equipment and tools

cleans works areas, equipment and tools

performs duties in compliance with safety regulations

performs other assigned duties related to the above

JOB QUALIFICATIONS
